Dear Delegates,

The Nuclear Waste Management Organization (NWMO) is looking forward to speaking with you at AMO's annual conference in Ottawa.

Visit our booth on the trade show floor to learn more and get an update on the upcoming regulatory decision-making process for the Deep Geological Repository for Canada's Used Nuclear Fuel Project at a proposed site in the territory of Wabigoon Lake Ojibway Nation, near the town of Ignace.

We'll also be sharing our proposed approach to site selection for the NWMO's second deep geological repository, a project designed to safely contain and isolate intermediateand high-level radioactive waste, and potential new sources of used nuclear fuel.

We've just begun a two-year public engagement process, and we look forward to receiving your feedback on our <u>discussion document</u>. The input received from Indigenous Peoples and Canadians will be used to refine our approach before we launch the site selection process for this second repository, in 2028.

We hope to see you at the conference.
